
Observation of World Environment Day



Observation of International Yoga Day








National Cleanliness Drive








7 Day NSS Special Camp



The camp concluded with a grand fiesta on the final night, featuring a campfire and an array of celebrations, showcasing the talents and camaraderie of the students.





Induction Program








Cancer Awareness Class

outcomes, including improved public health knowledge, communication skills, and experience in organizing community outreach initiatives.




International Women's Day




Coding Competition
